Biographical & Historical Information: The Alpena Civic Theatre (ACT) produced their first play in 1956, called “See How They Run” at Ella White School. With the increase in productions and the need for more space ACT moved to Baldwin School for rehearsals. By the 1960s, ACT saw a need for a permanent space to rehearse and perform. With the permission of the City of Alpena, ACT moved into the Eagles Building, then owned by the City, for use as a theatre. Since then ACT has continued to provide community theatre performances for Alpena.
