Provenance note: McKim Family created these images, plates were given by Frank McKim to Robert Kujawa, who donated them to the library in c2012.

Biographical & Historical Information: Images taken in Alpena, Michigan at the McKim residences at 125 W. Miller (before c1905) and 112 W. Oldfield (after c1905) and the neighborhood. Many are of immediate family, others are unknown – extended family and neighbors. A few are of the McKim & Polzon business (fine line groceries) located at 109 Water St. in Alpena, co-owned by Curtis Howard (C.H.) McKim. Some are taken in what is believed to be the Long Lake area or other wooded area outside of town.

The immediate McKim family consisted of C.H. (father), Carrie (mother), Roy (older son), and Donnelly [Don] (younger son). Roy was a watchmaker and jewelry store owner during the time frame of the photographs, and Don was a student. Frank [Tankie] McKim, whom these glass plates were handed down to, was the son of Roy, and once Alpena's Fire Chief, retiring in 1973. C.H. died in 1928, Carrie died in 1930, and Frank died in 2001.

Scope & Content: 103 glass plate negatives and 1 photograph taken by the McKim Family during the years c1902 to c1908 in the city (mostly residential) and county of Alpena, Michigan. Some of the plates' sleeves have a number, e.g. (#2) – these numbers were written on the original sleeves of the glass plates, but no corresponding list came with the negatives.

Access: Open to research. Box is heavy – glass - handle with care. Cotton gloves must be worn to view this collection.
