After two years without a Used Book Sale, the Friends of the Library are happy to tell you that the 2022 sale is on. If you haven't yet gathered up the books you want to donate, now is the time to go through your bookcases and make

room for what you plan to buy at the sale. The Friends will be selling canyas library bags at the regular price of \$5.00 but we will also have free biodegradable bags to put your purchases in.

Here are the dates you need to know:

July 25th through August 5th - We'll be collecting books during this time.

Stop in to the library desk to donate your used books.

August 6, 8 & 9 is when we will be sorting the books. We will need volunteers for sorting! Volunteering at the sorting tables will give you a sneak peek of what's available. Being a member of the Friends of the Library will allow you to shop on the Pre-Sale date. If you aren't already a member, it only costs \$10 so be sure to join and sign up to volunteer to sort books so you can get early access to purchase.

August 10 from 6 to 8 pm. The Pre-Sale date is Wednesday.

August 11, 9 am to 7 pm. The first full sale day is Thursday.

August 12, 9 am to 6 pm. The second full sale day is Friday.

August 13, 9 am to noon. The last sale day - also Bag Day - is Saturday,.

Prices have not increased from the last book sale. We hope you will come to the sale for some bargains! Pegg Thomas, Spinners & Knitters club, is donating a handspun and knitted shawl. Tune in to find out how it could be yours.

The Alpena County Library's Summer Reading Program ends Saturday, July 23 with a Summer Reading Celebration for children and teens! The festivities kick off at 10:00am with a puppet performance by MellyPop! Productions followed by crafts, games, and treats from 10:45am to 2:00p. The puppet show is ideal for children ages 3 to 10, but all are welcome and no registration is necessary.

Youth (ages 3-9) earn a free drawstring backpack after logging 800 minutes read; tweens (ages 9-12) and teens (ages 12-18) earn a free book after 800 minutes read.
